\*The 'Quotation' category includes short comments about the importance of writing in the lives of students and/or comment about the writing process.

\*\*All high school senior poetry and short story submissions are automatically entered into competition for a cash prize: either \$50 for Best Senior Short Story or \$50 for Best Senior Poem.

Rules:

- SUBMITTING TEACHERS MUST BE MEMBERS OF STELA.
- Teacher or individual students may submit entries.
- Class sets will not be judged. Judges are volunteers. Please submit the best from class sets to be fair to our judges.
- Teachers may make suggestions for the revision of the writing and should see that works are edited for spelling, punctuation and typographical errors.
- Illustrations and black and white photographs are welcome and may be used in the anthology. No membership required. We recommend that you scan the original and email the file. The entry form should be attached to a photocopy of the artwork.
- *On the Horizon* is the ONLY student writing publication sponsored by the Saskatchewan Teachers' of English Language Arts.
- Who receives a copy of *On the Horizon*? Students with work included in *On the Horizon*, school libraries of all students who submitted work to *On the Horizon*, and teacher members of STELA.

The entry form MUST be firmly attached to the entry. All entries become the property of the Saskatchewan Teachers' of English Language Arts and will not be returned.
